


Do not disturb or remove any historic relics or artefacts

A self guided walk has been developed for you to learn more about the history, flora and fauna of the Union Jack Reserve.

Information is provided at points of interest along the way.

The short walk will take you about 40 minutes, past historic diggings, and one of the old home sites. You may even catch a glimpse of some of the elusive wildlife.

The longer walk will take about two hours. On this walk you can learn more about frogs, tree dwelling mammals and visit the mine site and rest area at Locomotive Hill, where two men lost their lives in 1933.
